TRACES-UMR 5608 is a research laboratory based at the University of Toulouse Jean Jaurès in France. It has over a hundred permanent members and over fifty doctoral students. TRACES is a laboratory for archaeology and history that examines past societies over the long-term, from the earliest periods of prehistory to the medieval period, and across a broad geographic area in Eurasia and Africa. Members and doctoral students are grouped into several teams. TRACES conducts around forty programmed excavations in France as well as fifteen or so abroad, half in the Mediterranean Basin and half in Africa (Morocco, South Africa, Namibia, Togo, Benin, Ethiopia, Djibouti, Chad...). TRACES is equipped with a technical and scientific platform during and following excavation, for the study and refitting of archaeological artefacts, analyses of the materials, experimental archaeology, imaging and geomatics.
